



10 Ways to Find the Water Filter that's Just Right for You

1. What it is that you don't like about your water at the moment?

This is the first question we ask people. Without knowing what you want to change about your water it's impossible to come up with the right filter for you.

2. Is there anything specific that you want to filter out of your water?

You may not like the taste or smell of your water, so it might just be chlorine that you want to filter out. Or, you may be sick and tired of having hard water and want to find some way of treating limescale.

3. Are you on mains water or do you have a private water supply?

This will make a difference to the type of filter you'll need.

4. Do you want to filter the whole house or just your drinking water?

Drinking water filters are much smaller and lower cost than whole house filters, so this is vital to ask yourself. No need to spend more than you have to.

5. How big is your house?

If you want to filter your whole house then it's important to understand how many taps/loos you have because this will impact on the size of mains water filter that would be right for you.

6. How many people live in the house?

This is an important consideration as there'll be more demand on the water supply.

7. Where do you want to install the water filter?

This will depend on whether you just want to filter your drinking water or the whole house. A drinking water filter would normally be installed under your kitchen sink. A mains water filter can be installed there too, but it's governed by where the stopcock is in your property.

8. What's your budget?

This is always a necessary consideration. Our filters start from £68.99.

9. Are you committed to keeping up with your cartridge renewals?

You'll need to change your water filter cartridge every 6-12 months on average. They're not expensive and much cheaper than continually buying bottled water.
